RESUMEN

Municipal statutes are legal tools ratified by the municipal legislative power, establishing rules in the corresponding scope. These rules have the aim of regulating different activities, over which the Municipality police power is exercised. Many of these activities are related to public health, because they can cause diseases in the population exposed to them. The practice of tattooing and piercing is one of these activities able to cause diseases. Due to this fact, the Municipality of Córdoba has sanctioned statute 10962 in order to control this ancestral practice.
